ELIGIBILITY

If you have lived in an Australian rural area, Australian Statistical Geographic Standard (ASGS) Remoteness Areas (RA) 2 to 5, for **5 full years consecutively (must be 60 full months)** or **10 full years cumulatively (must be 120 full months)**, and you want to be considered for the Rural Access Scheme, you will need to provide this **completed form along with documentary evidence to support your application.**

Note: The rural residence claimed must be your current or previous primary residence and cannot include future places of residence. If you attended boarding school you can use your family's address as your primary residence, however, holiday homes, investment properties and secondary residences do not qualify.
